
PLEASE WATCH YOUR SPEED!!!

I am happy to report they did not have any discrepancies or concerns and found everything to be in good order. Shortly you will be receiving a copy of the full report form Norris & Associates via mail. The full report will also be made available on the NCF Website.

Planning for the future

In an effort to increase the earnings of our reserve funds, and in accordance with our by-laws, we have placed \$20,000 in a FDIC insured CD. The CD will yield 5.5% over the next 13 months. We continue to look for other like investments to place additional funds in an effort to ensure the community is prepared for any major expenses in the future.
