Annual Meeting

North Carroll Farms Annual Community HOA Meeting Will be on Monday May 2, 2016

At North Carroll Senior Center, 2328 Hanover Pike, Hampstead, MD

The major topic for discussion will be the repaving of HOA owned roads. The roads will need to be repaved in the next 3 - 5 years, estimates for this work have been \$100,000+. Each home (homeowner) will be responsible for an equal portion of this cost. That is \$450+/- per household. The discussion will involve the best method to cover this cost.

- * Raising the annual dues over the next three (3) years
 - A one time special assessment (\$450)
- Special assessment over the next three (3) years (\$150).

This is a very important matter and needs the co-operation of every homeowner to reach a fair and reasonable decision.

Also on the agenda:

A representative from the Town of Hampstead will be present to answer question about the town's future plans.

Chief Meekins will speak regarding police issues in the town and our community.

Get an update on the state of the HOA.

Election of three (3) board members to serve new three (3) year terms.


